

FAQ

What should I do if my license reached the limits?

A: You can renew it for the same fee amount or upgrade it to a higher license.

Will the voice tags be removed after purchase?

A: Yes, you will no longer have the tags on the beat you have purchased. Some beats may have the Producer's signature though.

Can I return or exchange a beat that I have purchased?

A: No, all sales are final after payment.

Can you change/modify a beat on request?

A: No, unfortunately I can't. All of my beats on the site are as is. However, if you purchase the Unlimited or Exclusive License, you get the Trackouts/Stems of the beat so you can just instruct your engineer to make the changes for you.

What payment methods do you offer?

A: I accept PayPal, Western Union, MoneyGram or direct deposit (Guinea-Bissau). If you would like to pay via Western Union, MoneyGram or direct deposit please email me at beatsbydiima@gmail.com for further instructions.

After purchasing a beat, will it still be available for sale?

A: Yes, the beat will still be available for sale on the site, unless the Exclusive rights are purchased. Then the beat will be marked as Sold and will no longer be available for other artists to lease.

Exclusive rights to a beat I leased previously have been sold. Do I need to worry?

A: No, as long as the distribution number described in your licensing contract is not reached, you won't need to worry at all. If this point of sale is reached and/or further sales are desired, further rights with a new sales cap can be obtained with a new license or license upgrade. License owners of any type of non-exclusive rights may upgrade their current license to the highest available non-exclusive license such as Premium or Unlimited.
